International Competition

Photo Contest 2022

Theme: "AN INVINCIBLE SUMMER"

Preamble

Fondazione Culturale Panathlon International-Domenico Chiesa¹ (hereinafter Fondazione Domenico Chiesa) and Fondazione per lo Sport del Comune di Reggio Emilia, in cooperation with Fondazione Palazzo Magnani, are organising a photo competition on Fotografia Europea theme "An Invincible Summer", a concept that draws inspiration from Albert Camus' insightful words: "*In the depths of winter, I finally learned that within me there lay an invincible summer*".² The contest will culminate in an exhibition in the framework of the "OFF Circuit" of the Fotografia Europea Festival organised by Fondazione Palazzo Magnani, which will take place in Reggio Emilia (Italy) from 29 April to 12 June 2022.

Article 1 - Scope

Promote the Olympic principles and Panathlon's purpose towards achieving the sporting ideal and upholding its moral and cultural values as an instrument for the development and advancement of the individual and for solidarity among men and peoples.

Article 2 - Objectives

Select images that effectively convey the messages emerging from sport in view of using them in the exhibition and in cultural awareness campaigns, with no commercial purposes whatsoever and exclusively in the framework of the international panathletic Movement.

Article 3 - Who may enter and how to enter

The competition is open to young people aged **from 18 to 25 years, from all countries of the world.**

Every applicant may enter the competition FREE OF CHARGE by completing the entry form, including the privacy release declaration, attached to these Rules, to be accompanied by a copy of an identity document.

Every entrant may participate in the competition with no more than 4 (four) photographs, to be sent in digital file format via WeTransfer to Fondazione Domenico Chiesa, c/o Panathlon International, object: "Photo Contest 2022", e-mail address: fondazionephotocontest@panathlon.net **by 27 March 2022 at the latest.**

² Camus' "Invincible Summer", evoked in his 1954 lyrical essay "L'Été", may be considered an ode to resilience, a common catchphrase these days. But there is more: it is an "ode to that vivid and pulsating energy that, irrespective of painful experiences and hardships, we do have inside ourselves. Yet that often leaves us unaware because we can no longer feel that energy, possibly forgotten or lost. The path towards our personal growth is sometimes nothing but a journey of rediscovery of that original vitality, silenced though not stifled, within ourselves."

Article 4 - Technical Specifications

The photographs must be in JPG format, 300 dpi, size 3872x2592 pixels, in black and white or in colour.

Each photograph must be accompanied by a caption including the photographer's Given Name and Surname, the technical characteristics of the photo and its title, if any.

Article 5 - Exhibition

Among all the photographs entered, the Judging Panel will select 30 photographs to be displayed at the exhibition that will be held in Reggio Emilia (Italy), at a location to be determined, from 6 April 2022; the Judging Panel will select the three photographs that will take the podium.

Professional-quality prints of the photographs selected for the exhibition will be provided by the organisers (maximum size: 40x50).

Article 6 - Use of the photographs entered in the contest

Every photographer, being the holder of all his/her original rights, is personally liable for the photographs submitted. Every photographer will retain ownership of the photographs entered in the contest, but he/she will transfer, free of charge, unlimited rights of use of such images to the organisers of the competition that will be entitled to publish and circulate them in magazines, newspapers, web sites and in whatever information and advertising media, provided that they do so on a not-for-profit basis and that the names of the author or authors of the photographs are indicated every time. Panathlon International may in no event transfer the photographs entered in the competition to a third party for any reason or cause whatsoever.

Article 7 - Judging Panel

The Judging Panel will comprise a representative from Fondazione per lo Sport, a representative from Fondazione Palazzo Magnani, a representative from Fondazione Domenico Chiesa and a representative from Panathlon International.

Article 8 - Prizes

First prize: 1,500.00 € and a plaque + an overnight stay at a hotel in Reggio Emilia;
Second prize: 1,000.00 € and a plaque + an overnight stay at a hotel in Reggio Emilia;
Third prize: 750.00 € and a plaque + an overnight stay at a hotel in Reggio Emilia.

The price of the hotel stay may not be redeemed for cash.

Two special prizes will also be awarded: the “People’s Choice Award” and the “Panathlon Clubs’ Choice Award”. Both will consist of a one-year subscription to a highly-rated international photography magazine.

At the discretion of the Judging Panel, Honourable Mentions may also be granted.

The “People’s Choice Award” will be awarded to the author of the photograph which will receive the highest number of votes among those published on the web site and on Panathlon International’s social channels.

The “Panathlon Clubs’ Choice Award” will be awarded to the photograph which will receive the highest number of votes from the Clubs.

Article 9 - Award Ceremony

Prize-giving will take place on 7 May 2022 during the award ceremony of Fotografia Europea “OFF Circuit”; the venue will be notified in due course of time.

Article 10 - Publicity

The “Photo Contest” will be publicised through the web sites and social channels of the three organising entities.

Notice of the results of the contest and of the winners will be given to each entrant via the social media or their e-mail addresses.

The entrants shortlisted for the exhibition will be invited to attend the award ceremony.
