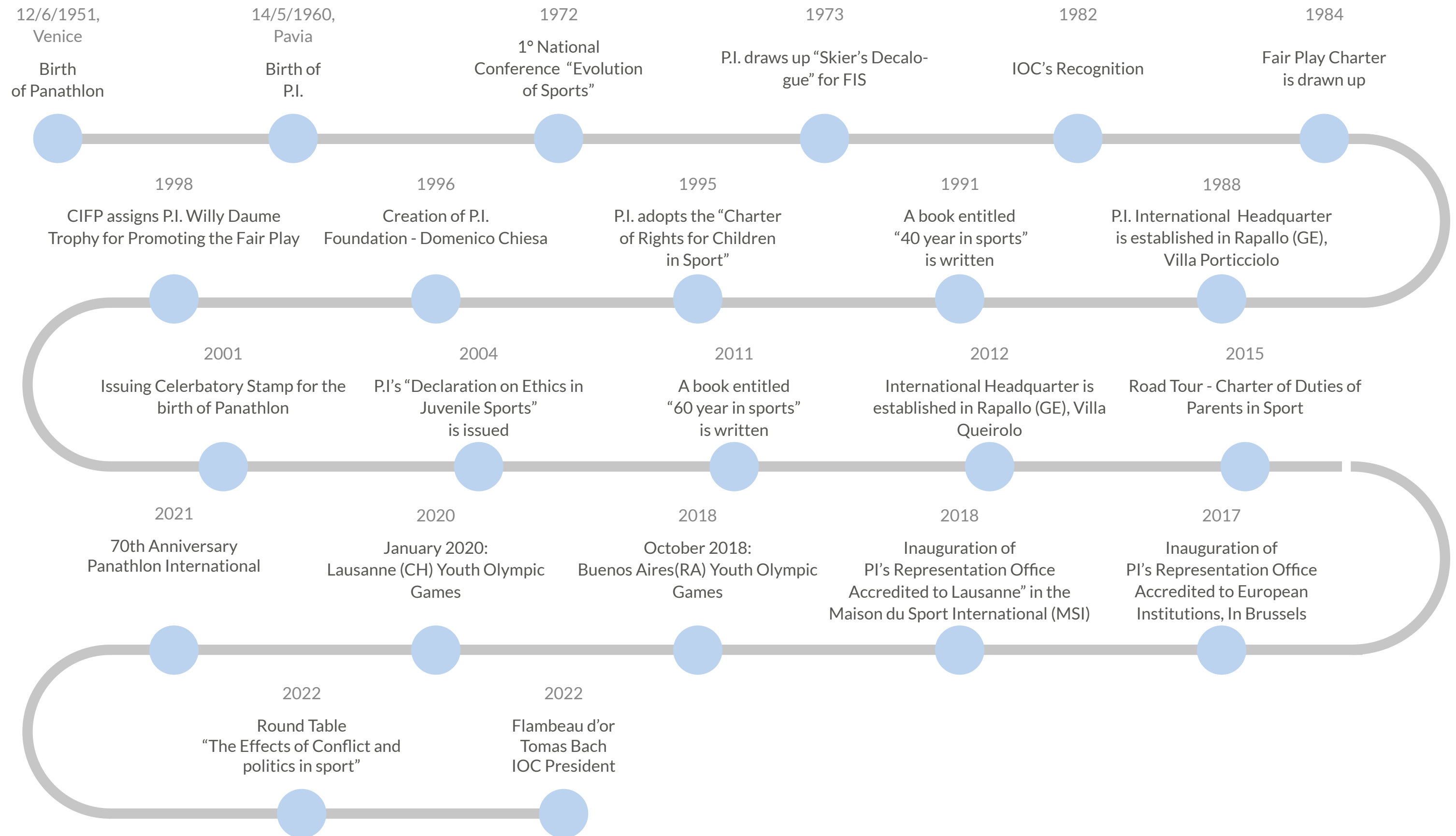

Panathlon is an International Movement for the promotion and dissemination of culture and sports ethics, according to the official recognition of the IOC since 1982, it aims to deepen, and disclose as well as to uphold the values of sports, seen as a training tool for the enhancement of the individual and vector for solidarity between men and peoples.

The term “Panathlon” originating from the Greek language can be translated with the expression “entirety of sporting disciplines”, while the motto “Ludis iungit” stands for “united by sport”.

It has a single emblem: made up of a blue colored background disk, setting at the center the gold image of the Olympic torch lit and written around it “Panathlon International”.

The whole is contained in a double circle divided into five sectors with the colors of the Olympic circles.

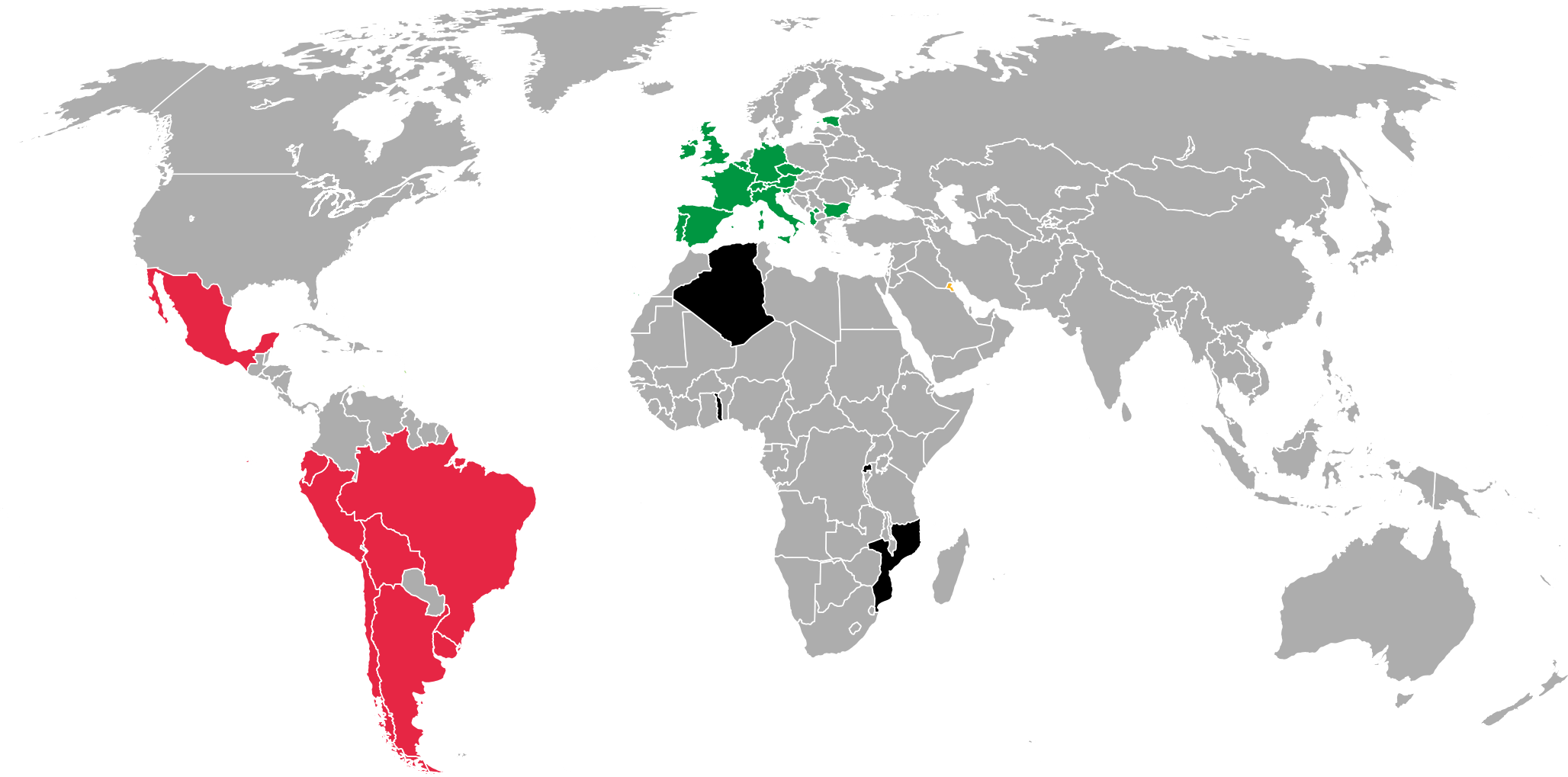

Panathlon International (P.I.) is the association of all Panathlon Clubs.

Panathlon implements the unity of the movement and runs it with the support of clubs gathered together in Districts ideally on a unique territory and jointly represented.

Panathlon International is, non-partisan Association, without sex or racial distinction, race, creed or color and is a non-profit making body.

Panathlon Clubs are basically founded on members' volunteering. Currently Panathlon International is present in over 31 countries representing 4 continents with approximately 9,000 members.

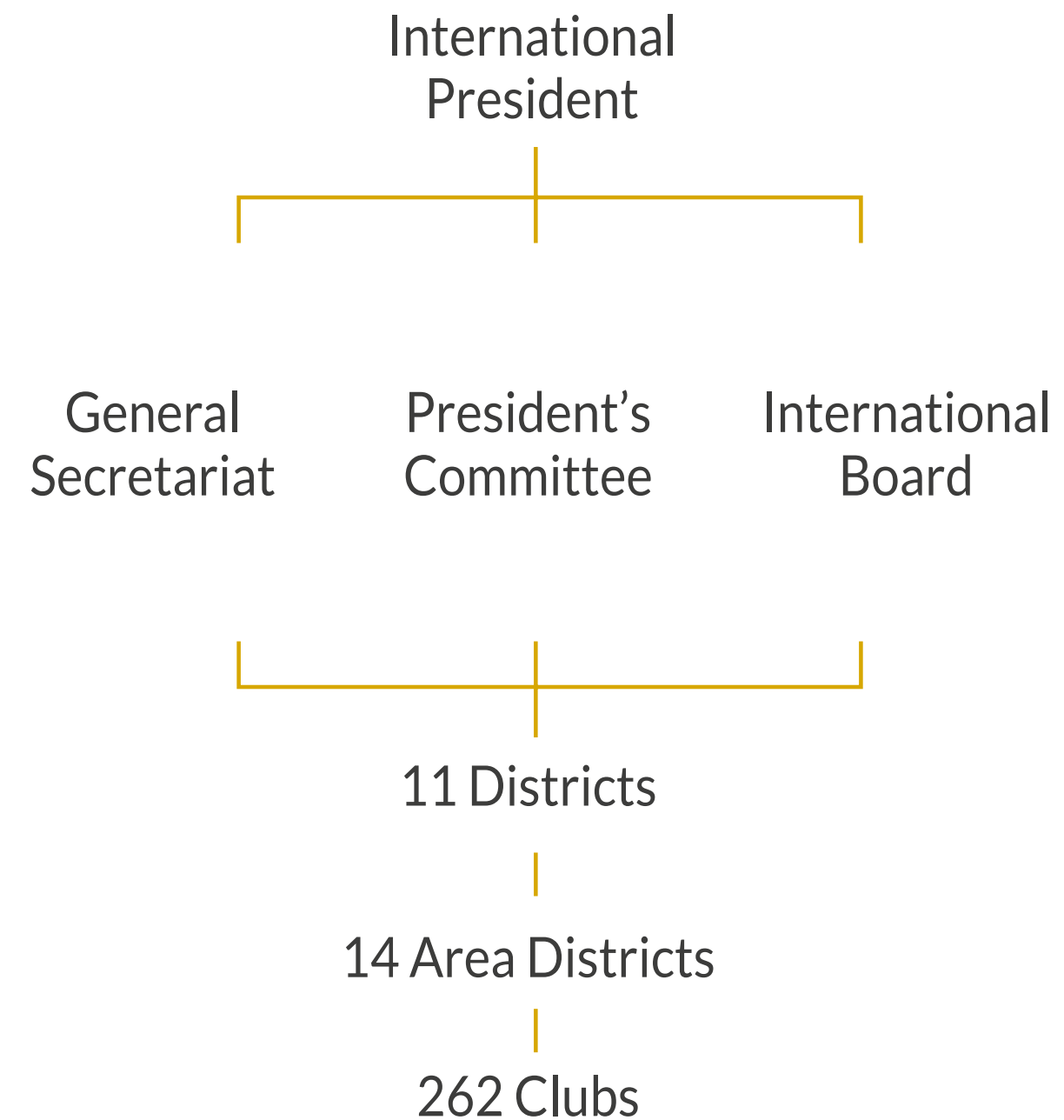

Club

The Clubs are all members of P.I.

They form and function as a service club in accordance with the rules of the Panathlon International Standards and Regulations.

Each Club is represented by its President elected by the Assembly of Members

Each club is governed by its own Statute

Clubs organize social gatherings during the year and may constitute Junior Clubs (JC) in accordance with the rules established by the Regulations.

I Panathlon Club

1. I Club sono i componenti del Panathlon International. Essi si costituiscono e funzionano come Club di servizio secondo le norme dello Statuto e del Regolamento del Panathlon International. Ogni Club è rappresentato dal suo Presidente eletto dall'Assemblea dei soci.
2. Ogni Club è retto da un proprio Statuto, secondo le norme statutarie e regolamentari del Panathlon International.
3. I Club organizzano nell'anno incontri sociali.
4. I Club sono tenuti a:
 - a) inviare tempestivamente alla Segreteria Generale, al Presidente del Distretto e al Governatore d'Area tutte le informazioni attinenti a variazioni dei Soci, alla composizione dei propri Organi, nonché alle attività sociali;
 - b) inviare annualmente ai medesimi destinatari, entro il 31 marzo, copia della relazione morale e finanziaria dell'attività svolta unitamente al verbale dell'Assemblea dei Soci;
 - c) versare ogni anno, alla Segreteria Generale del P.I., entro i termini stabiliti dal Comitato di Presidenza, le quote di affiliazione pro-capite deliberate dall'Assemblea Generale;
 - d) i Club, chiedendo l'associazione al P.I., s'impegnano altresì, pena la non ammissione e/o l'esclusione, ad aderire automaticamente e di fatto alle forme associative che, nel rispetto delle regole giuridiche e fiscali, ogni Distretto riterrà di costituire, previa l'approvazione del Consiglio Internazionale*.
5. I Club possono costituire Club Junior (PJ) secondo le modalità stabilite dalle norme regolamentari.

Areas

An Area corresponds to an existing administrative unit including both the area of a region and the area of a confederate County with at least 5 Clubs.

Areas take the name of their regions or confederate County.

Clubs of different regions if bordering, or in case of particular geographic or linguistic needs can be grouped into an Area regardless of their number.

Districts

For organisational purposes, when there are a minimum of three Clubs, these are grouped in a national District corresponding to the territory of a Country after which the District is named.

Districts are headed by a President, according to statutory rules.

For countries where there are less than three Clubs, such Clubs may be included in an already existing District of a nearby Country and the Presidents of said Clubs may represent Panathlon International in their country's authorities, including sports authorities. The Expansion Commission of P.I. is responsible for coordinating the Clubs that are not associated with any District.

I Distretti e le Aree del Panathlon International

I Club, almeno due, ai fini organizzativi, sono raggruppati in un **Distretto** corrispondente al territorio di una Nazione della quale assumono la denominazione.

I Distretti sono retti da un Presidente secondo le norme regolamentari.

Per le Nazioni nelle quali vi è un solo Club esso può confluire nel Distretto Sovranazionale oppure in un Distretto di un Paese vicino regolarmente costituito e il Presidente del Club rappresenta il Panathlon di quel Paese.

I Distretti sono finanziati dalle quote di affiliazione dei Club i cui criteri di determinazione sono fissati dall'Assemblea del Distretto.

L'attività dei Distretti è disciplinata, oltre che dalle norme statutarie e Regolamentari del P.I., da un proprio Statuto o regolamento distrettuale, approvati da apposita Assemblea distrettuale e reso esecutivo dal Comitato di Presidenza del P.I., sentito il C.G.S. del P.I.

Un'Area corrisponde ad una entità amministrativa esistente che comprenda sia il territorio di una regione, sia il territorio di uno stato di un Paese federato con almeno 5 Club.

Le Aree assumono il nome della loro regione o del Paese federato. 3. I Club di regioni diverse se confinanti, o in caso di esigenze geografiche o linguistiche particolari, possono essere raggruppati in una Area indipendentemente dal loro numero.

Il Presidente del Distretto, ove concorrono l'estensione geografica o il numero rilevante dei Club, autorizza la costituzione della nuova Area, previo parere del Governatore interessato e la sottopone al Consiglio Internazionale per la ratifica del provvedimento.

Le Aree sono finanziate dalle quote di affiliazione dei Club i cui criteri di determinazione sono fissati dall'Assemblea della propria Area.

Panathlon International is recognized by the International Olympic Committee (IOC), and associated with the International Fair Play Committee (IFC), at the International Council of Sport Science and Physical Education (ICSSPE); it has a well established regular connection with the European Union within the framework for the European Week of Sport (EWoS) and with EPAS (Enlarged Partial Agreement on Sport), organized by the European Council, with the European Fair Play Movement (EFPM).

In order to create a synergetic and continuous relationship with the European Institutions, a Panathlon International Representation has been constituted in the European Institutions with an office in Brussels, and a similar office is based in Lausanne (Switzerland) with the task to pursue and increase relations with the International Olympic Committee and the International Sport Federations as well as with institutions and other Organizations aiming at studying and developing the various aspects of sport in the area of Lausanne.

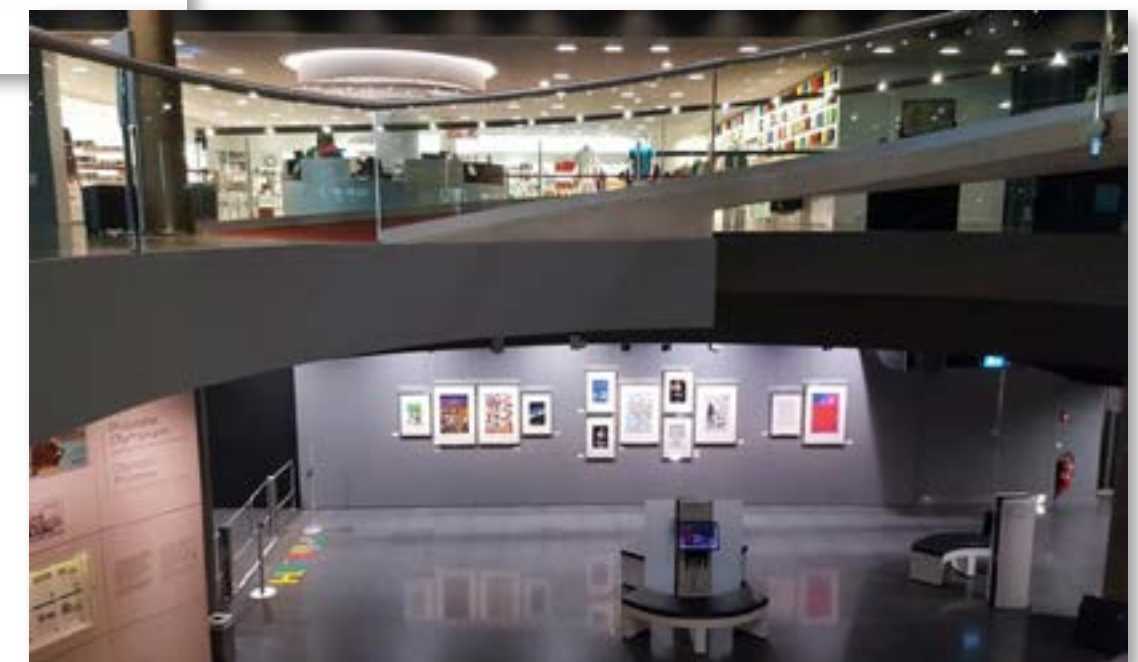
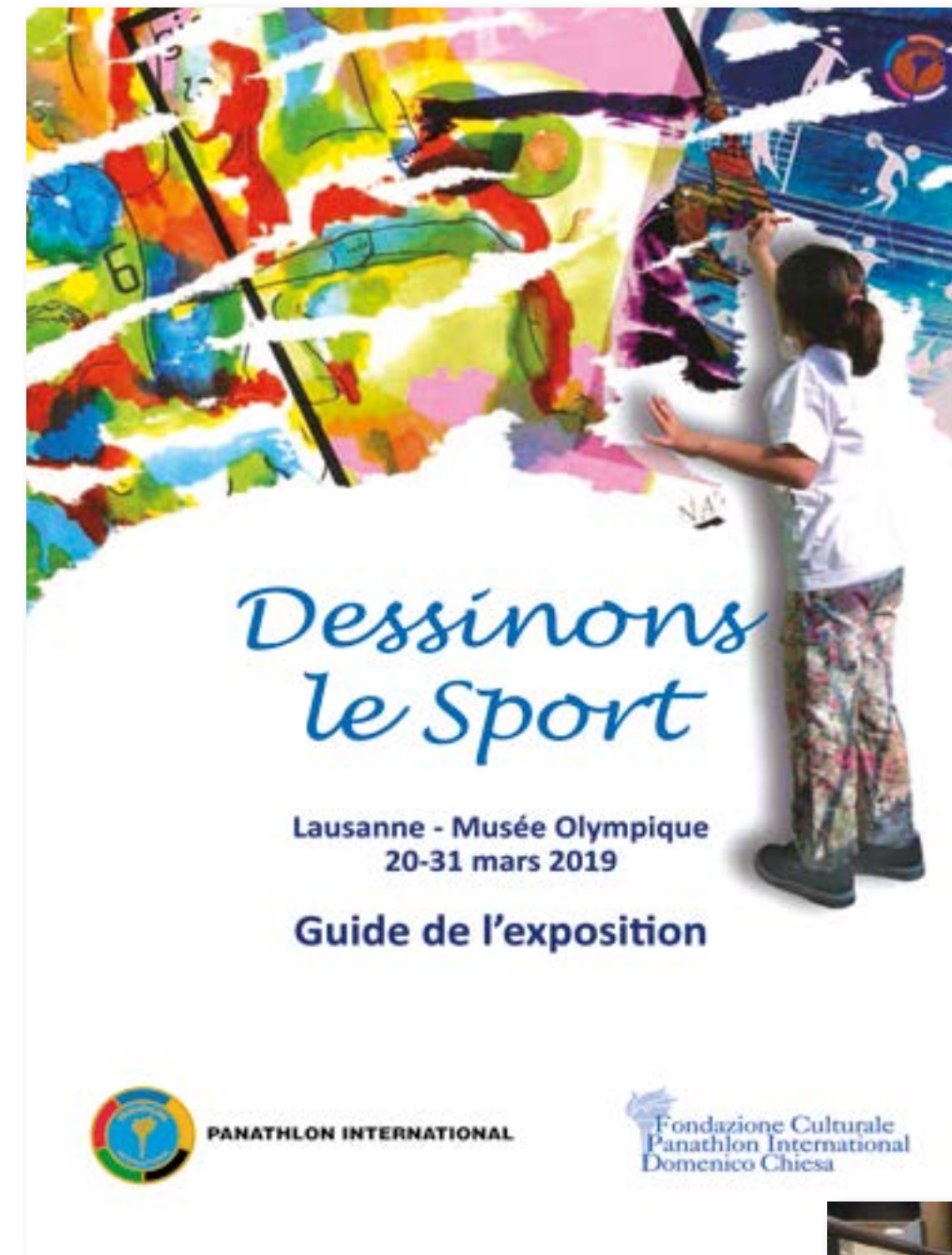

The Foundation, together with Panathlon International, has held graphic art competitions among Art Schools and High Schools in the 32 countries where Panathlon has a presence.

In 2019, the Foundation exhibited an anthology of the best works from 17 editions at the Olympic Museum in Lausanne.

Currently, together with Panathlon International, it carries out visual art projects to promote Olympic values (see item "P.I. projects").

Panathlon International in 2004, has decided to set up the “Domenico Chiesa Award” to be given on proposal of each single club and on the basis of a proper regulation, to one or more panathletes or non-member personalities who have lived the Panathletic spirit.

In particular, this award will be presented to whoever promoted the sporting ideal and has made an exceptional contribution:

- To the understanding and promotion of values fostered by Panathlon and by the Chiesa Foundation through cultural tools inspired by sport
- In promoting friendship among all panathletes and all those who operate in the world of sport, thanks also to their attendance and quality of participation in Panathlon’s activities, promulgating both among members and non-members the concept of friendship in all sport’s components, well aware that Panathlon’s ideals are of fundamental importance in the education of young people.
- In being available for services, thanks to the activity carried out for a Club or to one’s generosity towards a Club or the world of sport.

Panathlon International launched its first big permanent action, which has become the “Fil Rouge” of all Panathlon’s activities worldwide: this action promotes sports education as a cultural element for young people.

Among its aims, this action provides support to the International Olympic Committee in the achievement of its objective, fixed in the Olympic Charter, of educating young people worldwide, through sport, to develop mutual understanding and friendship, thus contributing to create a better world.

Panathlon International is the only sport movement recognized by the International Olympic Committee (IOC)

Panathlon International every two years holds its International Congress.

- **Fair play starts from school:** the project is aimed at all pupils/pupils of schools of all levels, starting from kindergarten. But also to their parents. *“If a society wants to protect its children, it must begin by taking care of the parents”* (John Bowley).
- **Project Charta Smeralda:** in collaboration with the One Ocean Foundation, P.I. intends to promote, through sports and its Clubs, awareness for the protection of the seas, oceans and waters. The goal is to spread the Charta Smeralda (a code of ethics to share principles and actions to protect the oceans and waters) and implement concrete actions and public events to engage young people and citizens on this issue.
- **International Visual Arts Competitions (free of charge) organized together with the P.I. Foundation - Domenico Chiesa:**
 - *International Photography Competition* for young people from 18 to 30 years old with the aim of selecting images that effectively communicate the messages that sport can deliver, which can be used for exhibition and cultural awareness campaigns, without any profit motive and within the exclusive scope of the International Panathletic Movement.
 - *International Video Competition* in collaboration with FICTS with the aim of selecting short videos (max 4 minutes) on themes decided from time to time always related to sport. Winners are awarded during the “Sport Movies & TV” in Milan.
